Information

The seventh academic symposium entitled "Planned and normative protection of space and environment" represents the continuation of activities that APPS started in 2001.

The symposium is an opportunity for the experts in the fields of spatial planning and design and environmental protection, as well as the representatives of state and local authorities and non-governmental sector, to meet and exchange experiences.

The intention of the symposium organizers is to discuss the current situation in the area of creation and implementation of planning documents in Serbia and the legal environment in which these documents are created. This is a particularly opportune time for this conference to be held, having in mind the announced changes of legal framework in the area of spatial planning and environment protection, as well as the adoption of a series of regional spatial plans and spatial plans for special purpose areas in the territory of Serbia, as planning acts that expound the spatial development of the territory of the Republic, defined by the Spatial Plan of the Republic of Serbia. The balance between economic and other activities and the environmental protection, as well as the achievement of overall sustainable development of Serbia, represent an important aspect of creating these documents.

This year, a special accent is placed on the issues of waste management in spatial and urban plans. Having in mind the importance of this subject and the wide range of scientific and professional approaches to solving this problem, this is an opportunity to exchange scientific experiences from Serbia and from abroad and to improve the methodology of waste management planning. At the same time, the growing trend of using landscapes and rural areas as a backbone of tourism and the economic development of Serbia demands a different, proactive approach to the planning of these areas, in accordance with the principles of sustainable development and the protection of non-renewable resources.

Along with the presentation of current practice from the countries of this part of Europe, we also expect the national authors to take an active role and the exchange of knowledge to take place, which will improve the methodology and the concepts of planning and use of natural resources, as well as reviewing new technologies which contribute to this process. Positive experiences from previous six symposiums, 313 presented and published papers, with over 3,000 pages in six almanacs, present a good precondition for the organization of yet another successful symposium. Therefore, having in mind the importance of the above mentioned topics, we invite you to take part in this symposium and contribute to its success.
